<b>Abstract:</b>	Composed of correspondence, publications, photographs, audio tapes, videocassettes, artifacts, newspaper clippings, and scrapbooks of Speaker Tip O'Neill. Most of the material relates to O'Neill's career in Congress, and documents his views on such issues as the Vietnam War, Watergate, and relations with Ireland. Also includes papers of O'Neill's staff, files of Democratic Committees, and some letters of late twentieth-century presidents.

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## Biographical Note

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Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr. was born to Thomas P. and Rose Ann (Tolan) O'Neill on December 9, 1912, in North Cambridge, Massachusetts, a section of town once called "Old Dublin" because of the high concentration of Irish families; he was the third of three children. His mother died when he was nine months old and for his first seven years he was raised by a French-Canadian housekeeper, Rose La Blanc. When O'Neill was eight his father married a woman named Mary Cain. By this time O'Neill was being called "Tip," a nickname that came from a popular baseball player of the previous generation, Edward O'Neill, a master at drawing walks and fouling off pitches, thus, "Tip" O'Neill. Many O'Neill male children were given this nickname. Originally a bricklayer, O'Neill's father became active in Cambridge politics first as a member of the Cambridge City Council and then as Superintendent of Sewers. He was known in the neighborhood as the Governor and was a generous man. Throughout his life O'Neill recalled that his father taught him five important lessons: 1) Loyalty; 2) Live a clean and honest life; 3) Remember responsibilities to fellow men; 4) Remember always from whence you came; and 5) Politics as a profession depended on your honesty and integrity. Neighbors often remarked that the younger Thomas was like his father and he tried to live up to him and these ideals.

O'Neill attended his parish grammar school, St. John's, and the high school, St. John's High. He graduated from St. John's in 1931 where he was captain of the basketball team. Even in high school he was active in local politics. He worked for various candidates and helped get out the vote by making sure everyone had a ride to the polls. In 1935 O'Neill entered political life with his first campaign, trying for a seat on the Cambridge City Council as a senior at Boston College. This was his first and only loss. This was the campaign in which O'Neill learned that "People like to be asked" and "All politics is local." In November of the next year, 1936, after graduating from Boston College, he was elected to the Massachusetts House of Representatives, the first of 25 consecutive elections spanning 50 years of public service. The Great Depression had hurt his constituents and O'Neill became a strong advocate of New Deal liberalism.

On June 17, 1941, he married Mildred Ann Miller, "Millie," his high school sweet heart. In 1947 he was elected Minority Leader of the Massachusetts House of Representatives and in 1949 he became Speaker of the House and the first Democrat since the Civil War to hold that position. O'Neill had thought about running for governor of Massachusetts after two or three terms in the Massachusetts House. Instead, when John F. Kennedy gave up his seat in the U.S. House of Representatives to run for the Senate in 1952, O'Neill ran and was elected in his place.

Cultivating his constituency, O'Neill secured his political base and was reelected every two years for the next 34 years. He was appointed Majority Whip of the U.S. House of Representatives in 1971 and in 1973 was elected Majority Leader. In 1977 he was elected Speaker of the U.S. House by acclamation. Throughout his years he supported civil rights bills, antipoverty programs, Medicare, and federally funded health care. As one of the few remaining New Deal Democrats, he became a national leader who never lost touch with his constituency. He counseled his colleagues to pay close attention to constituent service because "All politics is local," and he transformed the speakership from a focal point of inside maneuvering to a position of national political leadership.

O'Neill was unstintingly loyal to the Democratic Party, reminding people that his party was the party of the working people, the poor and the needy. O'Neill's relationships with presidents and foreign leaders include a long list of some of the twentieth century's greatest men. In 1967 O'Neill announced his stand against U.S. involvement in Vietnam, one of the earliest to do so. He called the war "the most frustrating conflict in American history." In 1974 he played a pivotal role in managing the Nixon impeachment proceedings. His relations with President Jimmy Carter were strained and as his party's highest ranking official he found the anti-liberal attacks of the Reagan administration difficult to tolerate. Still, O'Neill remained steadfast in his philosophy and emerged as a popular figure when he retired in 1986, ending 50 years of public service and a record tenure of ten consecutive years as Speaker.

After retirement O'Neill published two books. *Man of the House*, which appeared in 1987, soon became a best-seller. O'Neill's second book, *All Politics is Local*, was published in 1993. O'Neill also received many honorary degrees, awards, and tributes. Of special importance were the Laetare Medal, received from the University of Notre Dame in 1980, and the Ignatius Medal, received from Boston College in 1981. In 1991 O'Neill was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President George Bush. The citation reads in part: "Tip O'Neill had an uncanny ability to understand people and politics ... his demonstrated faithful service to the people also well serves the nation." On January 5, 1994, O'Neill died of cardiac arrest at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston. The Funeral Mass was celebrated at St. John the Evangelist Church, Cambridge, his home parish. Burial took place at Mt. Pleasant Cemetery, Harwich, Cape Cod, Massachusetts.

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## **Scope and Contents**

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The Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr. Congressional Papers document the Speaker's career in the U.S. House of Representatives. Much of the material was generated by the Speaker's staff, though O'Neill's personality is apparent throughout the collection. Politics at the highest level of government never overshadowed constituents' concerns. O'Neill's identification with the common man and his generous sense of humor are preserved in the papers.

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The papers are organized in eight series: I. Personal/Office Files; II. Staff Files; III. Legislative Files; IV. Grants/Projects/Subject Files; V. Party Leadership/Administrative Files; VI. Press Relations; VII. Audiovisual Materials; and VIII. Artifacts.

## Scope and Contents

As a Representatives in the House O'Neill ran for election every two years. This material documents O'Neill's campaigns for Congress, from the first, which was conducted in 1952, to the last one in 1984. The series includes correspondence with colleagues and constituents, particularly congratulatory letters on his becoming Majority Whip (1971) and Speaker of the House (1976), redistricting information, and memorabilia. There are further campaign items in the Artifacts series.

## Subseries C: Honorary Degrees and Awards, 1973-1987

### Scope and Contents

Honorary degrees were bestowed on O'Neill from such universities as Harvard, New England School of Law, and Trinity College in Dublin. Citations, programs, diplomas and correspondence document these degrees, which frequently were either Doctor of Laws or Doctor of Public Administration. Awards include several he received from Boston College, such as the Ignatius Medal. Prestigious honors from other institutions include the Harry S. Truman Good Neighbor Award and the Distinguished Service Award from the U.S. Association of Former Members of Congress. Many degrees and awards can also be found in the Artifacts series.

Some of the identified correspondents include Presidents Kennedy, Johnson, Ford, and Carter, Senators Edward Kennedy and Hubert Humphrey, and Speakers McCormack and Albert, along with foreign dignitaries and heads of state. Celebrity correspondents range from baseball great Carl Yastrzemski to entertainers such as Bob Hope and Dinah Shore.

### Sub-Subseries 4: Acknowledgments and Thanks

#### Scope and Contents

Once referred to as "Happiness" correspondence, these notes reflect O'Neill's more personal, non-issue oriented relationship with his constituents, friends, and colleagues. Length and topics vary considerably, from brief congratulatory notes on job appointments, wedding anniversaries, and birthdays to comments on how

government works in answer to inquiries from children. Although some of the briefer replies follow a formulaic pattern, it was not unusual for O'Neill to dictate letters to his personal secretary, Eleanor Kelley. Similar correspondence may be found in Eleanor Kelley's files (Series II, Subseries B.).

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## Subseries B: Eleanor Kelley Files, 1954-1986

### Scope and Contents

Eleanor Kelley served as O'Neill's personal Secretary during his tenures as Majority Leader and Speaker (1973-1986). Correspondence, congratulatory, and thank you notes to and from both colleagues and constituents can be found here, in addition to those in the Personal / Office Files (Series I. Subseries E. Sub-Subseries 4.). Files of special interest include material on St. Patrick's Day celebrations (1954-1983) and notes from White house Leadership Meetings held during Carter's presidency (1977-1980).

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## Series III: Legislative Files

### Subseries A: Legislative / Committee Files, 1970-1985

#### Scope and Contents

During his leadership years O'Neill, always responsive to constituent concerns, received considerable correspondence on legislative proposals before Congressional committees. These letters came from state and local officials, businesses, institutions, and lobbyists in response to domestic and foreign issues that affected O'Neill's district, Massachusetts, and New England. The correspondence together with background material, brochures, reports, and news clippings reveal the dominant issues of that period. These files are arranged alphabetically by committee name.

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## Subseries B: Department / Agency Files, 1970-1984

### Scope and Contents

Similar in scope to the Legislative/Committee Files (Series III. Subseries A.), these records reflect the issues and programs of governmental organizations and their accountability to Congress and constituents. Letters questioning the policies of agencies regarding consumer safety and well being, frequently accompanied by background material, were received, acknowledged and handled by O'Neill and his staff. These files are arranged alphabetically by department or agency name.

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These early records contain correspondence on legislative issues of general concern to constituents from O'Neill's district. Beginning with the 83rd Congress (1953), O'Neill's first term as a congressman, the material traces critical issues of the time from atomic energy to water fluoridation. Included are acknowledgements and background material. Arranged alphabetically by subject within each congress, it is possible to trace an issue over several years.

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## **Subseries F: Congressional Record Statement, Voting Records and Interest Group Ratings, 1953-1986**

### **Scope and Contents**

O'Neill's House floor statements, inserted comments, and extended remarks as they appeared in the Congressional Record are gathered here. Following these statements are his voting records for each session of congress, including those times he cast a vote as Speaker. The Speaker of the House, usually, votes only if his would be the deciding factor. This section also includes legislative ratings from various organizations, such as the National Federation of Independent Business. The organizations rate representatives based on a comparison of voting records to the groups' legislative interests.

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## **Subseries G: Democratic Steering and Policy Committee, 1973-1987**

### **Scope and Contents**

The formation of the Democratic Steering & Policy Committee (DSPC) was one of several reforms suggested by the Hansen Committee in 1973 as a response to "perceived inefficiency in congressional performance." The committee was created within the Democratic Caucus to serve as a leadership forum for considering and promoting party policy, especially legislative priorities. It is commonly considered a "leadership dominated" committee whose membership includes the Speaker, Majority Leader, Majority Whip, Chairman of the National Democratic Campaign Committee and other top party and committee leaders.

The majority of the information in these files was generated by the DSPC staff. By far the largest amount of material in these holdings are in Sub-Subseries 1. Jack Lew's Files (1973-1987). Jack Lew served as a Legislative Analyst on the DSPC from 1980 to 1985. In 1986, he succeeded Ari Weiss as Executive Director. Sub-Subseries 2. Malcolm Russell's Files (1975-1980) contain background material that predates his tenure as a researcher with the DSPC in 1980. Sally Ericsson worked as a Legislative Analyst on the DSPC staff from 1983 to 1986, though her files span a greater time range (1975-1987); her files are found in Sub-Subseries 3. Ari Weiss served as Executive Director of the DSPC staff from 1979 to 1985. Prior to this position he had been a valued research assistant and House floor liaison on O'Neill's Majority Leadership and Speaker staffs. Again, Weiss's files (1975-1985), found in Sub-Subseries 4., reflect material gathered as background that predate his time at the DSPC.

Files from the above staff members, combinations of them (Sub-Subseries 5. and 6.) and general files (Sub-Subseries 7.) cover a wide array of topics similar to those found in other sections of the collection. Budget files deal with the Balanced Budget Amendment movement. Energy issues covered include the Synthetic Fuels Task Force and the National Energy Conservation Act of 1979. Health files provide information on National Health Insurance ideas. It is within the DSPC Files that material on the National Commission on Social Security Reform and other Social Security issues can be found. Other highlights include information on the Auto Industry and the Economy, especially the balance of trade problems between the United States and Japan during the 1980's. Democratic Party related documents contain Platform Committee files from the 1980 Convention. There is also information on State-of-the-Union Messages and Television Network Response Time for the Democratic Party.

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## Sub-Subseries 2: Vietnam

### Scope and Contents

U.S. military involvement in Vietnam generated a great amount of constituent interest which is documented through correspondence, telegrams, surveys, background material, and bills. In his newsletter of September 1967, O'Neill stated that "As a citizen, Congressman, and father, I cannot help but wonder whether this [the Vietnam War] may not be too high a price to pay for an obscure and limited objective." The responses to this announcement, a reversal of his previous pro-war stance, provide an overview of the resulting dialog between O'Neill and his constituents.

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### **Sub-Subseries 3: Watergate**

#### **Scope and Contents**

From May 1972 through August 1974, the Watergate Affair elicited considerable constituent correspondence, telegrams, mailgrams, and petitions. Citizen's opinions on the impeachment of President Richard Nixon were tallied and statistics gathered. Included here are O'Neill's acknowledgements and responses to this flood of mail.

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## Subseries B: Local/Project Files, 1953-1985

### Scope and Contents

Gathered here are correspondence and related background material regarding legislation of vital interest to the citizens of Massachusetts. These records document O'Neill's early involvement (1953-1970) with issues directly impacting the area's economy. His commitment to such projects as the Boston Naval Shipyard, Massport, and urban renewal is evident. Correspondence demonstrating O'Neill's continued loyalty to Boston College is recorded here.

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## Subseries C: Grants, 1964-1986

## Scope and Contents

Herein are collected notifications and summaries of grants awarded by the federal government to individuals, businesses, social and educational institutions. Especially prevalent are grants awarded for health and education projects in O'Neill's district. Included are copies of grant applications and reports sent to O'Neill for the purpose of soliciting his support.

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## Series V: Party Leadership/Administrative Files

### Subseries A: Whip Office, 1961-1986

#### Scope and Contents

As Majority Whip (1971-1972) O'Neill was at the core of the Democratic Party in the House of Representatives. A strong party loyalist and a knowledgeable parliamentarian, he was well suited for the responsibilities of assisting Speaker Carl Albert and Majority Leader Hal Boggs. O'Neill's mission as Whip was to muster enough support among his Democratic colleagues to ensure victories for the Party's legislative programs and policies. These records document his backing of efforts to revise the Rules Committee's power, of which he was a member, in order to make it more responsive to the Party Leadership. In addition, background information on the office itself and Whip Notices provide a longer historical perspective than O'Neill's term as Whip.

## Subseries B: Majority Leader, 1974-1976

### Scope and Contents

O'Neill, as Majority Leader (1973-1976), was second in command to Speaker Carl Albert and chief spokesman for his party on the House floor. An accessible leader and skillful in the art of compromise, O'Neill took an active role in restoring public confidence in the legislative process during the post-Watergate period. He revitalized the Democratic Caucus to support the restructuring of the committee system. The significant portion of the records from O'Neill's Majority Leader years is found within the Congressional Organization files.

## Subseries C: Speaker's Office, 1977-1986

### Scope and Contents

By virtue of being elected Speaker of the House of Representatives O'Neill became the highest ranking officer of the Congress. He identified five roles of the Speaker: representative of his own congressional district; leader of the majority party; presiding officer of the House; chief administrator of the House side of the Capitol building and grounds; and Legislative Branch representative at ceremonial occasions. These duties translated into the power to control legislative scheduling, recognition on the Floor, appointments to committees, and signing legislation. O'Neill recognized the sometimes conflicting elements of the Speaker's job to be both partisan leader and impartial presiding officer. He realized the limits of authority that an independent minded House entailed and set as his goal "the task of reestablishing our rightful authority and trying to restore public confidence in the Congress..."

The papers in this section reflect the variety of duties O'Neill dealt with as Speaker. These include meeting with new members, tracking votes on major pieces of legislation, initiating leadership information packets, and opening the House to television coverage. In addition, they cover ceremonies honoring individuals, such as Anatoly Shcharansky, along with providing the State Department information on congressional delegations travelling overseas.

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## Subseries E: Congressional Organizations, 1968-1986

### Scope and Contents

In order to reestablish Congressional authority Party Caucuses were revived. Members of each party organized to discuss legislative strategy and encourage party unity. Under O'Neill's leadership an effort was made to transform the House into a more open body. As a result of these reforms and due to the greater independence of younger members known as the "Watergate Babies," Congressional caucuses began to develop along lines other than that of Party. These files reflect O'Neill's relationship and involvement with the Democratic Caucus, Democratic Study Group, and Democratic Steering & Policy Committee (DSPC) as well as regional groups like the New England Congressional Caucus and Northeast-Midwest Congressional Coalition. It was in these and other groupings that a moderate to liberal atmosphere provided a forum for instituting change.

Especially interesting are the files on the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee (DCCC), which raised money to assist candidates. As Speaker, O'Neill often supported the DCCC's efforts by speaking at fundraisers and receptions.

## Series VII: Audiovisual Materials

### Subseries A: Photographs

#### Scope and Contents

Over 7,500 photographs document O'Neill's life and career, from his days at Boston College and in the Massachusetts State Legislature through his terms in Congress, as a member of the Democratic leadership, to the final tribute he received upon his retirement in 1986. The largest segment records O'Neill's tenure as Speaker of the House of Representatives (1977-1986). As Speaker, O'Neill received numerous visitors to his Capitol office. His door seemed always open to presidents and colleagues, visiting dignitaries and constituents. There are images of O'Neill with Presidents Ford, Carter, and Reagan. Visiting heads of state include Margaret Thatcher, Anwar Sadat, Menachem Begin, and several Prime Ministers of Ireland. Luncheons in the Speaker's dining room featured guests such as Bob Hope, Sophia Loren, and Carl Yastrzemski. Constituents from business executives to school children visited O'Neill and posed for photographs with him, either in the Speaker's office or on the Capitol steps. Events covered in the photographs highlight the Speaker's travels abroad, charity golf tournaments, and occasions spent with his family; these present a more candid view of O'Neill to balance the posed photographs taken at formal receptions, dinners, and meetings. This subseries also contains several photo albums highlighting various trips both abroad and domestic which the Speaker took as well as events he participated in, including two Presidential inaugurations.
